



June's book of the month is Private Peaceful by Michael Morpurgo. You will have heard of War Horse, another First World War story by the same author. Private Peaceful is a novel for older children and young adults by Michael Morpurgo, first published in 2003. It is about a soldier called Thomas "Tommo" Peaceful, who is



looking back on his life from the trenches of World War I in France. Structurally, each chapter of the book brings the reader closer to the present until the story turns to present tense. The story especially underlines the senselessness of war and ineptitude of the commanding officer.

NEW PRESIDENT AND VICE-PRESIDENT

Rev Celia Cartwright, former minister of the Unitarian Chapel in Kendal, has been elected as the President of the General Assembly of Unitarian and Free Christian Churches for the year beginning April 2019.

Rev Cartwright was minister at Kendal Unitarians from 2006 until 2016 following ministries in Padiham and Rochdale and lay leadership roles in the West Country. She studied for the ministry at Unitarian College Manchester and has a BA (hons) Theology and Religious Studies from the University of Manchester. Before entering ministry she worked in retail sales and office work and then in the Queen Alexandra's Royal Army Nursing Corps.

Celia's parents were active Unitarians; her father being a lay preacher and her mother serving on various congregational committees. She attended Sunday Schools in various churches and was active in all aspects of church life. She is a former Treasurer of the Unitarian Peace Fellowship and a former District and then national President (2017-18) of the Unitarian Women's League.
